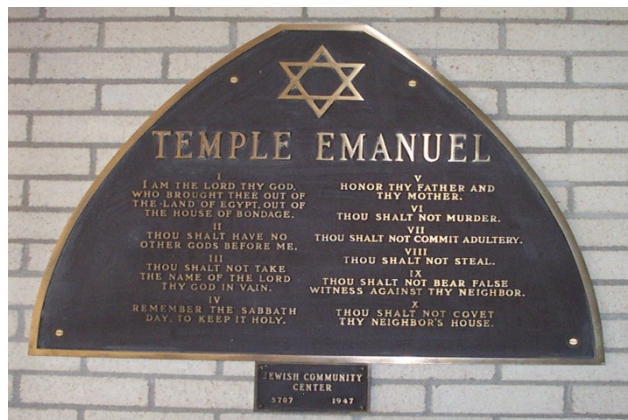

regular annual expenses

insurance.....	2,500
utilities	3,000
groundskeeping.....	1,500
routine cleaning & maintenance	2,500
administration & program expense (mailings, supplies, food, decorations, music, etc.).....	2,500
total	12,000

additional needs still pending*

replace drapes	1,000
install thermal shades.....	2,000
replace carpet entry/sanctuary .	3,000
repair/replace flooring rest of building.....	4,000
improve landscaping & fencing	5,000
paint & repair exterior.....	3,000
furniture & shelving.....	2,000
funds to hire musicians, bring in visiting rabbis/lecturers/other programming, otherwise enhance current offerings.....	?
emergency fund	10,000
